Dr. JAMES CALVERT

Dr. Calvert completed his Respiratory Training in Edinburgh and Oxford and was a Fulbright Scholar at Harvard University where he completed a Master’s Degree in International Public Health. He completed a PhD at the University of London and Cape Town where he examined the role of environmental influences on airways diseases in migrant African children in South Africa.

He currently works in Bristol where he is Lead Clinician in Respiratory Medicine and Deputy Chief of Staff at North Bristol NHS Trust, an 1100-bed Teaching Hospital. Since 2011 he has held a joint appointment as lead Respiratory Specialist for the South West Strategic Health Authority where he has worked with colleagues to improve access of respiratory patients to essential community services and to foster professional networks to improve clinical standards. He currently chairs the Professional & Organisational Standards Committee of the British Thoracic Society where he leads a project aimed at improving standards of service provision in Secondary Care. This work has recently been recognised with the award of a National Institute of Health Research Grant to assess the effectiveness of the interventions being tested.
